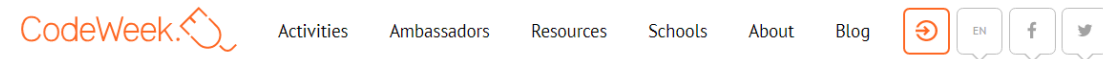



ADDING AN ACTIVITY TO THE CODEWEEK MAP

Adding the activity to the EuCodeWeek web page can be done before and after the activity.

1. Login to codeweek.com/login

2. Add a #codeEU activity

- **Activity title:** e.g. Innokas – color coding
- **Name of organisation:** choose an appropriate option
- **Organisaatiotyyppi:** choose an appropriate option (e.g. an open activity or for invited only)
- **Activity type:** choose an appropriate option
- **Description:** e.g. Our EuCodeWeek activity takes place in our classroom/school/etc.
- **Audience:** choose an appropriate option
- **Theme:** pick one or more (e.g. unplugged, playful coding activities)
- **Address:** write down the address of the event/activity
- **Country:** Finland

- **Start date:** choose the correct day
- **End date:** choose the correct day
- **Organiser's website:** <https://www.innokas.fi/tapahtumat/koodiviikkosuomessa/>
- **Public email:** leave empty or add and address for public distribution
- **Tags:** leave empty or use the tag given by the leading teacher of your area
- Code week 4 all code: **cw19-AO5RN**
- **Image:** optional
- **Contact email:** write down your own e-mail address (it will also be used as your contact information in the lottery)
- **Accept** the privacy policy terms
- Remember to click on **ADD ACTIVITY!**
